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INTRODUCTION

It is a horrible fact in human life, that good is realized by means of evil, truth by means of falsehood, beauty by means of ugliness, freedom by means of violence.

Things in life are not as they seem. As the Russian philosopher Nicolas Berdyaev pointed out, matters in this realm are often established through their contrary natures. These *contraries* may also be errors; they may equally be reflections, or they might be intentional manipulations. It could be said that the human life experience has been turned around and forced to face an existence increasingly unnatural to the innate human condition. And this existence is established through what is called the 'reality construct'. In each epoch, a particular reality construct is dominant, and this becomes the ruling consensus reality. These dominant reality constructs shift over time, yet they maintain hold over

how each generation or culture comes to regard and perceive the milieu of their lives. And such lives, I argue, have now come to be lived as within a reversal. Within the pages of this book, I refer to this reversal as the *Inversion*.

Human life is lived as a normalisation of this inverted reality construct. That is why life is filled with so many irregularities, oddities, and downright madness. We all know, or instinctively feel, that something has gone astray. There is no reason to celebrate absurdity within our so-called 'celebrity cultures'. Or to accept the military-industrialtechnological complex as the dominant force of political and economic governance. War profits the war mongers (and sellers), and plasticpeople governments allow the corporate gain of pain. We live in a construct where competition is praised, and 'weakness' is shrugged off as an evolutionary pruning mechanism. We allow our young minds to be programmed by blatant forms of mental and behavioural conditioning, and we willingly accept our debt-controlled enslavement by continuing to pay into the prison banks. Things have always been weird upon the planet, but now things have gotten a whole lot weirder. Only lies prevail; pseudo-truths are what get votes. We now believe in anything because nothing seemingly has any truth to it. We've become lost within the reflections of our own mirror world. Seeing our reflections smile back at us, we are content with the distraction. Everything must be okay, we tell our reflections—the governments wouldn't lie to us, would they? We're protected by benevolent authoritative structures that care for us like our mothers. Oh dear. Topsy-turvy.

To let you in on a little secret—it's been like this for a long time. Only that until recently, the waking dream of the Inversion was good at keeping everyone asleep (except the rare few) because the trickle of consciousness within the reality construct was low. But something has been happening, if you haven't noticed? There's been cracks in the veil, and more consciousness has been seeping through. And it's been getting into our heads, even if we hadn't noticed. Gradually, people have been gaining more and more awareness over this thing they call the 'human condition'. There have been a few exceptional individuals within each generation that spoke about these things, or even wrote about them; but few people listened and fewer still read any of their writings (because they had been kept illiterate, for the most part). But still, the gradual seeping of consciousness into this reality construct continued. And the insights kept coming. Some people

were inspired; others gained revelations. But the numbers remained small. The Inversion continued to impose itself; to keep the blinders on the dreamers whilst turning up the music. Greater distractions were offered; a glittering array of entertainment sprang up. And incentives were given to those people who began to open just one of their eyes. Those few who suspected something were spotted early on and fast-tracked up the hierarchy of the 'people pyramid' so that they benefited most from the pleasures and gains of the Inversion. Then these higher-ups would want to invest in keeping the system exactly how it was—a protection of self-interests. The masses of dreamers—the sleeping mob as they were called—remained swaying to the lullaby. But slowly, the frequency of the lullaby was being changed. A new vibration was being added. I think you get the gist of where this is going.

And it arrives to here: where you are sitting right now.

There is little time left for us to be idle. By facing some perhaps distasteful truths (or at least potential truths) we can be equipped with the necessary resources. For humanity to develop further, it must now face friction. Without friction, we may be facing a period of stagnation. In fact, there are forces within the Inversion that are pushing for a reversal in humanity's development. I refer to these aspects in this book as the *entropic forces*. Within the Inversion there are many examples of these reversals.

It is well known, for instance, that the inverted pentacle is used in black magic rituals, whereas the upright pentacle (see Leonardo's 'Vitruvian Man') is a sign for the correct orientation of the moral forces at work in the human being. Similarly, the symbol of the swastika (a Sanskrit word meaning 'well-being') has been used throughout the world in spiritual and religious contexts and is generally regarded as representing the power and energy of the sun. Yet its symbolism was inverted by the Nazi Party to be aligned with aspects of the Black Sun. Inversion techniques and strategies are going on all the time. In the past, a mystic or 'truth-speaker' would be turned into a heretic so as to invalidate their message. Today's version, the whistle-blower, is turned into a traitor and incarcerated. Puppet politicians are presented as heroes; pop-slaves as cultural icons; and tech-gurus as salvationist good Samaritans. The list goes on ... peace is inverted into anti-war so that the war energy remains embedded. Debt is reversed into credit, so everyone thinks they have economic freedom. The list goes on and on ... Again, I think you get the gist of where this is going.

It comes to here. It comes to us. And humanity has arrived at a point where it is embedded in deep materialism and is set to go deeper unless there is a move into greater conscious awareness. The machinic impulse is an extension of this so-far largely unquestioned myth of materialism. The human narrative, by placing materiality as primary, has created for itself a path that leads into a machinic future. And the social-cultural systems that are emerging to bring in this machinic future are orientated towards technocracy. The primacy of materialism has unfolded these events. Yet they do not need to become the human future. If there is a recognition of the primacy of consciousness, then the game plan changes. It is the agenda of the Inversion to get everyone enthralled with the game of life in reverse—and this reverse mode has the primacy of materiality as its foundation. If people could awaken their perceptions and understand more of the situation they are in, they would be less susceptible to the manipulations at hand. And when the true meaning of earthly events on the outer plane is understood—the recognition that politics, the economy, the culture industry, etc.—are like shadows cast against the wall of the cave, then real transformation is possible. Until then, humankind remains within the spectacle of an inverted reality construct. Yet that same construct is dismantling—and dismantling rapidly.

Stability is an illusion that comes from both our short-term lives and the larger tapestry of what we call history. The ship of civilisation has, it seems, been recently splintering into driftwood; and various parties are vying to grasp onto a floating piece. People are adrift too, and there are few life buoys in sight (that is, if you are looking through an external gaze). The crises that are erupting are part of the irrational makeup of life in reverse (aka the Inversion). I feel it is important to know where we are, and what's about our feet. That is why I ventured to write this book.

This book has been written to offer the discerning few a potential Ariadne's thread. Within these pages there are nudges—but not final answers. The reader must seek these out for themselves. There is work to be done. Yet the first step upon the long journey home is to recognise the place where we are each standing right now. Know your location; from this, you will have a better orientation of the next step to take. One step at a time—and watch out for those *false exits*!
